



Mr. Abdul R. Majied

March 3, 1925 - July 16, 2014

MAJIED, Mr. Abdul - age 89, passed away Wednesday, July 16, 2014 at his residence. Funeral service commencing at 8 a.m., Friday, July 18, 2014 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd. Inman Rasool officiating. Interment Flint Memorial Park Cemetery, G-9506 N. Dort Hwy., Mt. Morris, MI. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the funeral home 8 a.m. Friday.

Brother Abdul-Rahim Majied (Charley James McClendon, Sr.) was born March 3, 1925 in Hensley, Arkansas, the only child of Charley and Mary Ellen Rebecca McClendon. He attended Woodson Elementary and Dunbar High School in North Little Rock, AR. He served in the US Army in World War II and was honorably discharged in 1945. Abdul furthered his education through the GI Bill at Philander Smith College in Little Rock, AR. On June 22, 1946, he married Irene Halton and they were blessed with 10 children: Dorene McClendon-Salaam of Riverview, FL, Mary E. Bailey, Charley J. (Ella) McClendon, Jr. all of Flint, MI, Teresa A. McClendon-Marks of Grand Rapids, MI, Roger R. (Darlene) McClendon of Flint, MI, Khalilah S. (Enyichukwu) Obima of Ypsilanti, MI, Dawud A. (Lena) Majied of Flint, MI Gregory L. Majied of Indianapolis, IN; Maurice G. Majied of Flint, MI and Eric A. Majied of Dallas, TX. They also raised 3 beloved grandsons: Rahaman L. McClendon, Edrice A. and Rashad S. Weatherspoon all of Flint. Additionally he leaves daughter, Lenora Jones of Belleville, MI. Being the only child, gave him the desire for a

“house full of children”. Abdul, Irene and S.A. Halton (the youngest brother of Irene, whom he called his brother) left Arkansas and moved North as part of the “Great Migration”. They tried Detroit, but found success in Flint. Like their cousins, the Mitchell’s, they both obtained jobs in the auto factories. Abdul worked and supported his family primarily through his employment at Fisher Body, where he worked for 25 years. Abdul always sought knowledge from any and everywhere for him and his children. He had his children read newspapers, maps, books, graphs, and watch educational Television. Abdul made learning enjoyable and he always urged his own as well as other children to continue their education through college or vocational school and never give up, this was his “dream” for every child in the family. His main interest has always been God and family.

Brother Abdul-Rahim Majied leaves to cherish his memory: wife, Irene C. Majied; 11 children; 40 grandchildren; more than 50 great-grandchildren; 3 great-great-grandchildren; a host of other relatives and friends.
