She married Mr. William Lee Hodo on June 28, 1942 in Columbus, Mississippi. From this union 2 children were born. By 1950 she, her husband and children relocated to Flint. In 1955 Mrs. Hodo started working at DoBoys Donuts on Industrial Ave. After 15 years of employment there, she then joined the staff at McLaren Hospital and retired after 13 years of service.
