Mr. Alex Lang Jr. III was born March 8, 1941 in Gould, Arkansas, the son of the late Mr. & Mrs. Alex II and Alafair Lang. He moved to Flint, Michigan because of the rapid growth of the Auto industry. Alex eventually secured work at Grand Blanc Metal Fabricating, a division of General Motors. He retired after 45 years of service in 2006. Alex married Rose Lang in 1967.
