CAMPBELL, Mr. Alexander - Age 86, passed away Saturday, December 10, 2016 at his residence.

Family hour 10:00 AM Saturday, December 17, 2016 at Foss Avenue Missionary Baptist Church, 1159 Foss Ave., with funeral service commencing at 11:00 AM, Rev. Dr. Reginald G. Flynn officiating. Mr. Alexander Campbell was born June 2, 1930 in Fairmont, North Carolina, the son of Frank and Beulah Campbell. He was one of nine children. Alex met his high school sweetheart, Dorothy Lee Bethea and they wed in March of 1953. That same year Alexander and Dorothy moved to Flint, Michigan. To this union God blessed them with two daughters, Patricia (deceased) and Gloria of Detroit, MI. Alex became a member of Foss Avenue Baptist Church in 1956 and dedicated his life to Christ. He was employed at AC Spark Plug, a division of General Motors retiring in 1987. Alex furthered his education through the Mott Adult Education where he received his diploma in 1993 from Flint Northwestern High School. He served on various ministries while a member of Foss Avenue Baptist Church. Alex was a dedicated member of the Usher Board from the start of his membership until his transition. He also served as a Trustee, member of the Layman's, as well as the Food Pantry. Alex's

hobbies were traveling with his wife, Dorothy and attending every event possible that his grand and great-grandchildren participated in throughout the years. He had the greatest love for his family and the God he served until he was called home to be with the Lord.
