TAYLOR, Mrs. Alice Pearl - Age 61, passed away Friday, June 26, 2015 at Hurley Medical Center. Family hour 11:30 a.m. Monday, July 6, 2015 at Holy Ghost Church Ministries, 801 Addison St., with funeral service commencing at 12 p.m. Pastor Robert Burrell, Sr. officiating. Ms. Alice "Pearl" Taylor began her earthly journey on March 15, 1954. She was the 14th child born to the union of Wesley Sr. & Martha Bell (Burns) Taylor in Louise, Humphreys County, Mississippi. Pearl accepted Christ as Lord and Savior at a very young age at Holiday Chapel Missionary Baptist Church. To know Pearl was to know someone who loved the Lord with all of their heart, all of their mind and all of their soul. In life, she freely helped and advised so many people with her spiritual wisdom. It is believed that she left this life with an under estimation of just how many people loved, admired and appreciated her for all she had done for them. She was the perfect example of "Christ's Follower" to all who knew her. Pearl was a loving and doting mother to her children, Angela and Mack. Pearl later returned to her education and graduated from the University of Michigan-Flint with a Bachelor's degree. She then began a rewarding career with The State of Michigan, Department of Human Services where she was admired by her colleagues.
