Sister Alicia Inez Williams was born September 27, 1981, the daughter of Ms. Tania Townsend and Mr. Gary Thomas in Flint, Michigan where she was raised. Sister Alicia was a kind, and caring person with a loving personality and a pleasant spirit. To know Alicia was to love her. At an early age, Sister Alicia accepted Jesus Christ into her heart. She grew up attending Bethlehem Temple Church of God in Christ under the leadership of Pastor Nathaniel Lewis, Sr. who was also her uncle. She was very excited about her relationship with Christ and decided at an early age to make a commitment to love and serve God with her whole heart. She attended Flint Community School System, graduating from Flint Northern High School, "Class of '99". Sister Alicia then went on to attend the University of Michigan-Flint and received her Bachelor's Degree in Operations Management with a
