Even though she only had a 4th grade education, she raised a family and maintained employment as a home direct care aide for disabled individuals, and eventually retired from Genesee County Community Mental Health. For many years she was a faithful member of Unity of Faith Christian Church, where she served in both the usher ministry and the cleaning ministry. She enjoyed growing plants, watching sports, soap operas and comedy shows, and watching Sanford and Son was her favorite. Most of all, she enjoyed bringing her family closer together. She was a very giving woman and she did her very best at anything she set her heart to do.
