Alma was a resident of the Grand Blanc area for over 30 years. She accepted Christ at an early age at Pilgrim Rest Baptist Church in Benton Harbor, MI. In 1988 she joined Ebenezer Ministries where she was actively involved in several ministries including, Sunday School Teaching, Deaconess Board, Trustee Board, President of the Choir, and Mistress of Ceremony of many programs and events. Alma attended Benton Harbor Public Schools. Upon graduation she decided to further her education at Western Michigan University, where she was a member of Alpha Kappa Alpha and served as its President for two years. Alma immersed herself in her profession where she had a genuine love for students, staff, and community alike. The only thing that surpassed her passion for teaching was the love she had for God, family, and church.
