Alma Jean Johnson Hardy was born March 4, 1943, in Enfield, North Carolina to Hattie Johnson and Joseph Watson. She relocated to Flint, Michigan with her husband, Thomas Jefferson Harvey. From this union two children were born, Melvin Harvey and Thomas Harvey. After the death of her husband Alma moved to Chicago Illinois, where she met her husband Rev. Dr. James Hardy, Pastor of True Fellowship Missionary Baptist Church. They were blessed with Cordaro Hardy, Tierra Johnson, Xavier Hardy, David Hardy, Tiona Hardy and Joshua Johnson. Alma accepted Jesus Christ as her personal savior at a young age. Alma was a member of Vessel of God Ministries serving on the Mother's Ministry and in the Choir. She was also a member of the Veteran's Durm Circle – VA Saginaw, Michigan. Alma was a very talented entrepreneur founding Clean and Sparkle, a successful household and custodial cleaning service in the Greater Chicago area. Most recently she worked for Carman-Ainsworth School District Food Services and was known by the students as "Mama". Alma enjoyed teaching Sunday School, singing in the choir, cooking, providing home health care services, playing spades, attending Native American Pow

Wows, and shopping.
