Ms. Lampley will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 2PM-8PM Monday. Ms. Almeta Lampley was born in Flint, Michigan on December 20, 1973 to Amos and Azell (Crenshaw) Lampley. Ms. Lampley at a young age attended Garfield Elementary School and then Foss Avenue Christian School. In 1991, Almeta graduated from Flint Southwestern Academy then attended Mott Community College where she continued her academic studies, receiving her Associates Degree in Marketing Management in 2000. In the year 2000, she received her Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration from Ferris State University. Ms. Lampley worked over 12 years in retail sales as a manager at Fashion Bug and as a cashier at Krogers. She was also a co-owner of Beauty Blessings Apparel, with her close friend, Melissa (Rodgers) Mitchell. Almeta, accepted the Lord as her personal Savior at a young age, and was a member of the Foss Avenue Baptist Church for over 30 years, under the spiritual guidance of Pastor Avery Aldrige and later in life, Minister Derrick Aldridge. In 2004 Meta became a member of Faith City Church of Fenton, MI, where she loved to worship and celebrate in the spirit of the Lord. In the year of 2005,
