Alonzo Dean Norton passed away on November 10, 2024, at the age of 76, in Flint, Michigan. Born on April 30, 1948, Alonzo dedicated over three decades of service to the Flint Community Schools before retiring in 1997. He also owned and operated a computer building and repair business, showcasing his technical acumen and entrepreneurial spirit. A veteran of the U.S. Army, Alonzo served his country from 1968 to 1971, during which he developed skills and experiences that he carried throughout his life. He was a proud alumnus of Flint Central High School and furthered his education at Mott College. Alonzo was a passionate musician, proficient in playing both the piano and the organ. His love for music was matched by his commitment to community health and fitness; he was an active member of the CRIM Foundation and participated in numerous walk/run races, promoting wellness in his community.
