Mr. Alphonso Hooker, Jr. was born May 27, 1928 in Gibson County, Trenton, Tennessee, the son of Alphonso Sr., and Mattie Bell Hooker. Alphonso was a resident of Flint and a member of New Zion Baptist Church for many years, where he sang in the choir. He served in the United States Army from November 6, 1952 – October 25, 1954 with United Nations Service Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Korean Conflict Medal and Bronze Service Star. He retired with 31 years of service from Chevrolet Manufacturing (The Hole) and was a member of UAW Local 659. Alphonso loved games of chance, cooking and family gatherings. He was always a loving and caring person. Alphonso was also very passionate about the Lord and his family. He touched lives and hearts of everyone he met or came in contact with.
