Altha accepted Christ at an early age at Cedar Grove MB church under the leadership of Reverend Ashford. She attended elementary and middle school at South Union. She graduated from High School at Attala County Training school in Kosciusko, Mississippi. She relocated to Flint, MI in 1954. Eventually, she would attend Mott Community College, earning her Practical Nurse certificate. She was employed at Hurley Medical Center for 35 years and retired as a Med LPN in 1992. Altha became a member of Mount Sinai Missionary Baptist Church, under the leadership of Reverend JC Montgomery. She served as New Membership Clerk for many years and remained a faithful member under the leadership of Reverend Morris Collins. Her first love was God, she loved her family and loved caring for her children. Her reliance on God in helping her raise six children alone was evident in verses she was often heard

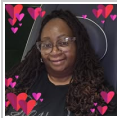
