RENICK, Mr. Alvin - Age 73, passed away Saturday, December 26, 2020 at Ascension Genesys, Grand Blanc, MI. Family hour 10:30 AM Saturday, January 9, 2021 from Christ the King Church, 1811 Seymour Ave Flint, MI., with funeral service commencing at 11:00 AM Father Phillip Schmitter, officiating . Mr. Renick will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home and may be viewed 12:00 PM - 6:00 PM Friday. Alvin Renick was born October 6, 1947 in St. Louis, MO to Albert and Susie (Cofield) Renick. He was the eldest of three boys which their parents were very proud of. Their family moved to Michigan as Mr. Renick pursued higher education and later settled in Flint, Michigan. Alvin attended Flint Community Schools, graduating from Flint Southwestern High School in 1966. He was also a faithful and active member of Christ the King Catholic Church a member of' the choir and The Knights of Peter Claver, Inc.

Alvin attended Tennessee State University, playing football, one of his many sport loves. He returned to Flint, beginning work at General Motors, eventually becoming involved in the Employee Assistance Program as a representative that helped many maintain as well as sustain their careers. It was there that his travels, negotiation skills, and love for helping people grow and realize their potential in the workplace. Al had a way of bringing people together, providing basic and sound advice, wise counsel and making people laugh.

In 1993 Alvin was united in holy matrimony to Audrey Campbell and they embarked on a blissful journey for many years. They understood each other and both shared their passion for animals, family, as well as being surrogate parents to several nieces and nephews. Alvin was interested in family history and would often talk to others about wanting to do a family tree. He was very connected to his friends and was always a phone call away for advice or a listening ear. He also had a love and gift for caring for fish, his saltwater and freshwater tanks were beautiful and serene. He also mentored youth in the Mr. Rogers' Urban Gardening Program providing training in leadership, life skill training, work ethics and financial training. Al traveled to Europe twice and visited many countries (Paris, Amsterdam, London, etc.) with Rome being his favorite. His lifelong dream was to go to the Vatican and the Colosseum. It was life changing for him.

Alvin met no strangers and it wouldn't be long before the conversation led to his love and knowledge of sports. Many referred to Al as "Mr. Big House" as he was Go Blue personified. He LOVED Michigan sports. He was a season football ticket holder, attendee to numerous bowl games over the years had a wardrobe to compete with any Michigan store, vintage or new. His sports paraphernalia and various collector's items are legendary. He also had an affinity for the Detroit Lions, Tigers, Red Wings, or any other Michigan team. He watched golf, tennis, racing, etc., on his big screen and was faithfully tuned in. Please do not talk about his teams! He was loyal! Alvin was the biggest Smokey Robinson Fan and thought that he was "hands down" the greatest singer on planet earth. He also liked to dress. Alvin had an eye for detail which was evident in his appearance and the manner in which he carried himself.

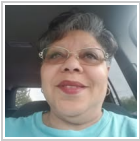
