Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12Noon-8PM Sunday. Mr. Alvis TeShawn Miller was born June 24, 1983 in Flint, Michigan, the son of Mr. & Mrs. Alvin and Ruby Miller, Sr. He attended Flint Public Schools, graduating from Northwestern, "Class of 2002." Alvis worked as an Athletic Assistant with the football and basketball teams for various high schools in the Flint area including Beecher Middle and High School. Alvis was currently employed at the Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, Inc. Mr. Miller accepted Christ at an early age and was a dedicated, faithful member of First Union Baptist Church, where he served in different capacities throughout the various ministries in his church with his most cherished being Director of the Youth Choir. Alvis' favorite hobby was going to church. He delighted himself in making his presence known in the House of the Lord every time the opportunity was available to him.
