Moon Funeral Home, and may be viewed from 2 p.m. - 8 p.m. Friday with family present from 2-4 p.m. Mr. Andre "Doc" Morris was born January 27, 1967 to Jofus and Cleopatre Morris in Flint, Michigan. Andre attended Flint Community Schools and was a graduate of Flint Northern High School, "Class of 1985." He was a skillful basketball player and was part of the 1983-84 Flint Northwestern State Championship Team, that was inducted into the Greater Flint Hall of Fame. In January of 1991, Andre married Eula Blake in Lapeer, Michigan. They were married for 19 years. He was a faithful member of 2nd Chance Church. Andre enjoyed spending time and playing with his grandchildren, nieces, and nephews, whom they affectionately called "Papa Doc" and "Unkie Dunkie."
