Angeline Brown was born October 30, 1934 in Lena MS to Cora Lee Williams and the late Eddie Washington. They moved to Flora, MS, where she attended Good Hope School and Flora High School. Angeline joined Fearn's Chapel Church, under Reverend Silas Smith, where she accepted Christ at an early age. She married Tommy Lee Johnson-West, and from this union a total of eight children would be born. They relocated their young family to Flint MI, and joined True Light Missionary Baptist Church, under the leadership of Reverend L.W Owens, Reverend Marcellus Burkett and presently Reverend Robert Rushing. She served faithfully as a member of the Choir, Usher Board, an amazing cook in the Kitchen Ministry and was still serving in the Nurses Guild at the time of her illness. She truly loved the Lord and True Light Missionary Baptist Church where she remained an active member for 60

Birthdays, holidays, and often times just dinner on Sundays became a family gathering. Those were the special times that we all came together to love one another. Angeline was a natural nurturer. Her beautiful and humble spirit could easily lift any heavy heart. She gave encouragement to family and friends. She taught us endurance through the hard times and instilled morals that helped us to be well rounded people. Her laughter and smile filled a room with so much joy it rubbed off on everyone.
