Annie was born on June 13, 1945 in Louisville, Mississippi, the fifth child of six children born to Rube Sr. and Susie Short Harrington. She was born fifteen minutes before her twin sister, Geraldine. Her earliest education took place in the public schools of Louisville. She graduated from Camille Street High School and Jackson State University where she earned a Bachelor of Science Degree with a major in English. For thirty-nine years she was an educator in the Flint Public School System where she taught English. Her passion for education and warm spirit impacted the lives of hundreds of young people. Annie's spiritual journey took her to Blackwell A.M.E. Church where she often shared her musical talent at the piano. Sandwiched somewhere in between her loves of God, family, church, people, and music, is another love, Annie's cooking. She loved to cook and was a fantastic cook. Annie was a member of

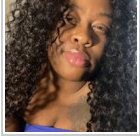
