HENDRIX, Mrs. Annie Virginia - Age 85, passed away Sunday, November 8, 2020 at Henry Ford Hospital, Detroit, MI. Family hour 10:00 AM Friday, November 20, 2020 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Mrs. Annie Virginia Hendrix was born February 12, 1935, in Cuba, Alabama, the daughter of A.J. and Emma Dora (Johnson) Talison Sr. Annie graduated from MSD (Michigan School for the Deaf) in 1953. She was active in baseball, fencing, track and field, basketball, and enjoyed sewing. She was a great cook, sewed quilts, crocheted, painted ceramics, worked crossword and word find puzzles, and religiously studied her bible. She married Joe Willie Hendrix Sr. in 1954. She spent most of her adult life in Flint, MI where she and Joe raised seven kids. Finally, she resided in Detroit, MI. She worked at Walli's Supper Club until she tested into the United States Post Office where she retired after 27 years in 1990. Annie was raised Baptist but became Pentecostal in her adult life and practiced her faith devotedly as a member of Riverside Tabernacle, Greater Holy Temple, Living Word Ministries, and Silent Assemblies of Pontiac and Detroit, respectively. Annie made sure her children and grandchildren attended church and deaf camp at Lake Faholo Park. Annie often traveled the

U.S. and abroad (Hawaii, Australia, Jerusalem, just to name a few). Annie had a gift for preserving foods. She froze greens, corn and other fruits and vegetables. She also canned stewed tomatoes, jelly, strawberry preserves and peaches. She also made some of the best desserts, pecan pie, ambrosia salad, pistachio pudding are a few of her specialties, but there were many, many more. Annie never shopped at the mall, she ordered everything from mail order magazines. She was an amazing, wife, mother, grandmother, friend, neighbor and role model. She never let her deafness define or limit her.
