June 30, 1925 - October 18, 2017

Age 92, passed away Wednesday, October 18, 2017 in Triangle, VA. Family hour 11:30AM Saturday, November 11, 2017 at Mt. Zion Missionary Baptist Church, 2109 M.L. King Ave. with funeral service commencing at 12PM, Pastor Rodney Ellison, officiating. Interment Sunset Hills Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 11:30AM Saturday. There will be no public viewing.

Mother Annie B. Holley was born June 30, 1925 in Eldorado, Arkansas, the daughter of the late John and Alice (Rogers) Everett. She lost her mother at the young tender age of 8 years old. Annie gave her life to Christ at an early age becoming a member of Morning Star Missionary Baptist Church in Eldorado, AR. She attended Eldorado Carver School. Mother Holley met and married her first love, Berry Holley on April 8, 1945 in Smackover, AR. They were married for 72 years. They moved to Flint, Michigan in 1954 uniting with Metropolitan Baptist Tabernacle later moving their membership to the Mt. Zion Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of the late Pastor, Rev. H.B. Dixson. Mother Holley was a faithful member of Mt. Zion for 50 years, where she served in many ministries: the Mother's Board, Mission, Culinary and Floral Ministry. She also attended GLBD Association Women's Dept. 3rd Thursday Monthly Meeting. Mother Holley was also active in the neighborhood block club. She enjoyed cooking for her family and friends being known for her pound cakes and blueberry pies. Mother Holley loved to

fish and creating beautiful ceramic pieces. She left this earth for her heavenly home in the early evening of October 11, 2017 peacefully in her sleep following a short illness.
