



Mother Annie Mae Wagner

WAGNER, Mother Annie - Age 91, passed away Friday, June 14, 2019 at her residence. Family hour 10:30 AM Saturday, June 22, 2019 at The Secret Place Tabernacle Church, 1701 Harrison St., with funeral service commencing at 11:00 AM, Pastor Will I. Morgan Sr., Eulogist, Pastor Nate Dennis, Officiating. Interment River Rest Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the Church 10:30 AM Saturday. Mother Wagner will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 2:00 pm-8:00 PM Friday.

Mother Annie Mae Wagner was born on December 2, 1927 in Orangeburg, SC, the daughter of Willie Garvin and Ida Thompson. In the late 1940's she migrated to Flint, Michigan with her mother and siblings where she resided until she went from labor to reward. She was married to the love of her life, Deacon Robert Wagner for 33 blissful years where they raised their family to see the fruit of true love and partnership.

Mother Wagner received the precious gift of the Holy Ghost over fifty years ago at Greater Emmanuel Temple Apostolic Church. Mother Wagner loved the Lord's house and took pleasure in serving in the kitchen ministry, on the Usher Board, in the choir and as a Deaconess. Although her health prevented her from attending for the last couple of years, she was a faithful member of Secret Place Tabernacle under the leadership of Pastor Nate Dennis until her passing. Mother was never too ill to praise the Lord and if you stopped by her

home, you would hear her remind you of the goodness of Jesus.

Mother Wagner opened her home to any and every one that needed a meal, a hug or a prayer. Her ability to nurture and love without restriction led to her becoming a licensed foster mother. She greeted all guests by saying "Praise the Lord". No matter how you encountered her, she took the opportunity to witness to you about the goodness of Jesus and let you know that "holiness is still right". Mother was small in stature but her prayers covered a multitude and she definitely knew the power of intercessory prayer. Her legacy can be summed up by one scripture:

Above all, love each other deeply, because love covers a multitude of sins (1 Peter 4:8, NIV).

Mother Wagner was a cook extraordinaire and made the best turkey gravy this side of heaven! There aren't too many times that you would enter her home and she didn't have a feast sitting on the stove. She loved to cook and her talents lead her to being the owner of the Lunch Wagon on Pasadena and Gillespie in the 1970's.
