



Mr. Anthony D. Veasey

November 1, 1963 - August 31, 2022

VEASEY, Mr, Anthony Age 58, passed away August 31, 2022 at his residence. Family hour 10:00 AM Saturday, September 10, 2022, from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., with funeral service commencing at 11:00 AM. Family and friends will assemble at the Funeral Home. 10:00 AM Saturday. Mr. Veasey will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home. Public viewing will be held during the family hour only. Anthony Dereck Harris Veasey, affectionately known as Tony, passed away at the age of 58 on August 31, 2022. Tony was born in Arkansas on November 1, 1963. His biological mother, Clara, died when he was a toddler. Tony was adopted by Clara's younger sister, Elizabeth, and her husband, the late Jimmy Veasey, and was raised in Flint, Michigan, as their only child. He accepted Christ at a young age and attended New Jerusalem Baptist Church. It was evident early on that Tony was a leader. As a teen, he was active in many organizations, including Flint's NAACP Youth Chapter, where he received a national award as a youth leader for the civil rights organization. He learned to swim at the Flint YMCA and went on to get his lifeguard certification there, as well. Tony graduated from Flint Northern High School in 1981. He was president of the senior class, a member of the varsity track team, the varsity swim team, and the yearbook staff. Swimming became a lifelong passion of his. He was always encouraging everyone, no matter your age, to learn to swim for fun and safety. Tony went on to attend Eastern Michigan University and was a member of the track team

there. He continued to be active in social causes. One of his proudest moments was when he participated in an anti-apartheid protest on campus that led to the university divesting its holdings in South Africa. He also joined Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., and participated in service and advocacy efforts with his chapter. He developed friendships that he kept for life. He was a dedicated Kappa and proud of the achievements of his fraternity brothers. The leadership skills he developed as a child and a young adult formed the foundation of his adult life. Tony received his Bachelor of Science degree in Health Care Administration from Eastern Michigan University. He earned a Master of Arts in Leadership and Change Management from DePaul University. He was successful in his career and somehow managed to land professional positions allowing him to work from home long before the rest of the world caught on to working-from-home during the pandemic. At the time of his death, he was employed as a Process Engineer by Bayer Corporation. Tony loved his family. He worked hard to keep The Harris Family Reunion going. He saw an opportunity with Facebook to strengthen family bonds by having a platform for ongoing connection, not just at reunions. He posted faithfully on the Facebook family pages and encouraged the rest of us to do so. Tony was the glue that kept the family together. Most of all, he was devoted to his mom, Elizabeth. He moved her to Illinois to be close to him and regularly took her on outings. Tony was preceded in death by his biological mother, Clara, his brother Lee Otis, and his father, Jimmy. Anthony Dereck Harris Veasey leaves his mother, Elizabeth Harris to cherish his memories. He also leaves four aunts: Annie Jean Ridgell, Leola Harris, Alice Harris, and Verlenda Harris; one uncle, James (and wife Bernestine), many dear cousins, and countless friends.

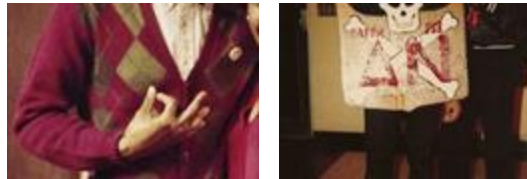
