JOHNSON, Mr. Arthur "Rabbit" - Age 75, passed away Saturday, July 31, 2010 at McLaren Regional Medical Center. Family hour 12:30 p.m. Saturday, August 7, 2010 at Mt. Zion Missionary Baptist Church, 2109 M.L. King Ave., with funeral service commencing at 1 p.m. Pastor Rodney Ellison officiating. Interment River Rest Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 12:30 p.m. Saturday. Mr. Johnson will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, and may be viewed from 12noon-8p.m. Friday. Mr. Arthur "Rabbit" Johnson was born to R.G. & Mabel Johnson, on July 14, 1935, in Jackson Mississippi. He was a graduate of Northern High School and went to Michigan State University on a football scholarship. He served in the military, and played professional football for the Toronto Argonauts and the Calgary Stampeders in Canada. He retired after a season with the Detroit Lions. He was a strong advocate for sports of any kind but his first love was football. After football he began working for General Motors and he retired from Truck and Bus . He was one of the first inductees for The Greater Flint Afro-African American Hall of Fame in 1992 and Greater Flint Area Sports Hall of Fame in 1996. Arthur leaves to cherish his memory, his wife, Barbara Johnson, 3 daughters and son-in-laws Monica & Clarence Frazier, Shonda & Mark Ingram, and Darla & Samuel Cook. Five grandchildren, Brandi Morris, Mark II, Miya, Mia and Malia Ingram, and great granddaughter Nariah Thomas.
