Audrey attended Flint Schools and graduated in 1979 from Flint Central High School. Upon graduation she entered Central Michigan University. She took additional classes at Shaw College and graduated with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Social Science/Sociology from the University of Michigan-Flint in 1984. Audrey relocated to the Detroit area and was employed by The Alzheimer's Association; Wayne State University as a director of clinical studies; Bridging Communities and Wayne County Catholic Social Service as an outreach coordinator. Audrey's most prized accomplishment was being a mother to her 13 year old daughter, Naomi Christine. They spent countless hours together talking, shopping, going to movies and doing almost everything together. Audrey and her daughter were members of Baber Memorial A.M.E.

Church in Detroit, Michigan where Rev. Larry Simmons was her Pastor. Audrey served as the Young People's Department Mentor for Girls. Audrey's memory will live on eternally by her daughter, Naomi Christine; parents, Mr. and Mrs. Harold and Ruth Boone; sister, Amye Leavy and her children Ervin Isaiah and Leah Ruth; brother, Richard C.
