Ben, Jr. was a graduate of Mason County Eastern High School in Custer, MI. and an Honorably Discharged Veteran of the United States Army where he bravely served his country in the Vietnam War. In 1984, he was united in Holy Matrimony to Willene Davis and from that marriage were three children; Lamont, Monica and LaTonya. Ben loved his family and took great pride in providing for them.
