Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 10 a.m.-6 p.m. Sunday with family present from 3-5 p.m. Mrs. Betty Jean Fullwood Wilkinson Galloway was born May 27, 1930 – as a bright flower of faith, hope and love. Betty, the daughter of Harvey Fullwood and Olivia Lemuel, was a native of Flint, MI. She was educated in Flint Schools. Betty attended Flint Community Junior College receiving her Associate Degree as a Registered Nurse. She married George W. Wilkinson in 1947 and to that union six children were born. Betty continued to pursue her educational endeavors. She soon received a Bachelor of Arts Degree from the University of Detroit in Psychology and later attended the School of Public Health at the University of Michigan. Betty received a Masters of Public Health, Child and Maternal Health in 1975. She excelled academically and was an avid seeker of knowledge and wisdom; she later attended Michigan State University where she obtained a Masters of Arts Degree with an emphasis in Education. Betty had a servant's heart of compassion; she was employed by the Visiting Nurses Association, City of

Flint Public Health Department, Hurley Medical Center, Tuskegee University, City of Saginaw Health Department, the State of Michigan Department of Licensure and retired from the Flint Community Schools at Genesee Area Skill Center. Betty loved the Lord Jesus Christ and committed her life to Him at an early age. She was a member of the Word of Life Christian Church. She loved to study the scripture, and encouraged others to seek and follow Christ. Her hobbies included shopping, reading, gardening, camping and walking. Betty was preceded in death by her first husband George W. Wilkinson, daughter Claudette M. Bryant, great grandmother Pauline Montgomery Williams, mother, Olivia Lemuel, step father Seth Lemuel and brothers Alfred and Jerry Lemuel. She leaves to cherish her memory her husband Layton L. Galloway. Layton was her faithful loving friend and caregiver.
