Billy moved with his family to War W. Virginia and attended the W. Virginia Public Schools, graduating from Excelsior High School. After arriving in Flint, he was employed by Blount Pest Control, Chevrolet Metal Fabricating Plant, a division of General Motors and a Asbestos Abatement Worker. He retired in 2003. Billy met and married Betty Washington Wesley in 1980 from this union one daughter was born. His Christian journey began when he united with Detroit Street Church of God. Billy later united with Mt. Calvary Missionary Baptist Church, where he was baptized and became a dedicated member of the Male Chorus.
