Mr. Bobby Carl Toliver, Sr. was joyfully welcomed into this world on August 24, 1957 in Detroit, Michigan, the son of Frank and Gussie Mae Toliver, whom both preceded him in death. He was the eldest of five children. Bobby accepted Christ at the early age of six. He received his education within the Detroit Public School System and graduated from Chadsey High School, "Class of 1975", where he played football as a Linebacker.
