



## Mr. Boyzie L. Mathis

June 17, 1944 - January 30, 2026

MATHIS, Mr. Boyzie L. - Age 81, peacefully transitioned on January 30, 2026, at Piedmont Hospital, Snellville, Georgia. Family hour 10:30 AM Saturday, March 7, 2026, from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., with a memorial service commencing at 11:00 AM Dr. Sabin Strickland, officiating. Family and friends will assemble at the funeral home 10:30 AM Saturday, March 7, 2026.

He was the beloved son of David B. Mathis and Rossie (Calloway) Mathis, he was the youngest of six children. Boyzie was preceded in death by his parents and siblings, David Mathis Jr., Albert Mathis, Febbie Goodlow, Geraldine Mathis, and Legretta Lyons.

Affectionately known as “Granddaddy,” Boyzie will be remembered most for the love, wisdom, and steady encouragement he shared so freely with family and friends. He will forever be remembered by his former wife, Joy Mathis; his daughter, Detra Fields (Tyson); his son, Boyzie Mathis II (Tiereni Wright); and his treasured grandchildren, Tyson Fields Jr., Taylor Fields, and Shaleigh Mathis. His grandchildren were the true joy of his heart, and he took special care to make each of them feel seen, supported, and deeply loved.

A proud graduate of Flint Central High School, Class of 1962, Boyzie began his professional journey with Buick, a Division of General Motors. In 1965, he was drafted into the United States Army and stationed in Germany with the

97th Signal Battalion, an experience he carried with pride and often reflected on through stories of growth, challenge, and adventure.

Following his military service, Boyzie returned to General Motors in Flint and built an extraordinary 40-year career marked by perseverance, leadership, and determination. Rising through both hourly and salaried ranks, he ultimately achieved the executive level status of Area Manager of General Assembly Operations, later continuing his leadership at the Doraville facility in Atlanta, Georgia. From his early days as a newspaper boy to completing the management program at GMI (Kettering University) and earning his Bachelor's Degree in Human Resource Management from Spring Arbor College, Boyzie believed deeply in learning, discipline, and personal growth.

Boyzie was always known for his style, earning the nickname "Stacy" for his love of Stacy Adams shoes. He was also an avid golfer who found peace, joy, and friendly competition on the golf course. Whether playing a round with friends or simply enjoying the game, golf was one of the many ways he connected with others and embraced life's simple pleasures.

His commitment to service extended beyond his career. In Flint, he served on the Board of the Flint Boys and Girls Club and as Vice President of the Flint Inner City Lions Club. He was a devoted member of Macedonia Baptist Church under Pastor J. C. Curry. After relocating to Georgia, he continued his faithful service at Pleasant Hill Missionary Baptist Church under Pastor Sabin P. Strickland, where he served as Deacon, Deacon Chairman, and Elder/Board Member.

Whether he was a colleague, mentor, friend, Dad or Granddaddy, he often shared wisdom, kindness, and his sense of humor.

Though Boyzie L. Mathis will be deeply missed, the lessons he taught, the love he gave, and the lives he touched will remain forever in the hearts of

those who knew him.
