Caldwell, Brandon Michael - of Flint, age 22, passed away Monday, February 12, 2007. Family hour 12 pm Monday, February 19, 2007, at Sacred Heart Catholic Church, 719 East Moore St., with funeral Mass commencing at 1 pm, Father Phillip Schmitter officiating. Interment Sunset Hills Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Mr. Caldwell now lies in state in the chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 10AM-6PM Sunday. Brandon was born November 25, 1984 in Flint, Michigan the son of Tony and Brenda Caldwell. Brandon graduated from Flint Central High School and also attended classes at Flint Northern, where he was part of the Magnet Program. Brandon attended Lansing Community College and was currently a student at Mott Community College. Brandon was a member of the Thespian Society while at Central and had aspirations as a play writer and movie producer. While attending Mott, he was a member of the wrestling team. Brandon was a published poet and enjoyed animals and computers. He also was a member of the Flint Chapter of Jack and Jill. Brandon was a volunteer with Special Olympics for many years and had a passion for history and cooking. Brandon was baptized at Sacred Heart at an early age. He was well loved by his family and friends.
