Brenda was the oldest of five children. She was baptized at an early age and united with Macedonia Baptist Church, where she was a faithful member and sang with the "Voices" Choir. She later joined Family Worship Center Church-Flint and remained a faithful member until her passing. Brenda was united in marriage to Robert Irving Wilson and to this union two beautiful daughters were born, Sabrina and Stephanie.
