Sims "Uncle Brother" was born August 31, 1934, in Livingston, Alabama, the son of Mr. Isaac and Mrs. Pearlie (Eason) Sims. After being Honorably Discharged from the United States Army on February 28, 1963, he later moved to Flint, Michigan, and retired from General Motors Corporation UAW Local #659. He was a faithful member and Deacon of Morning Star Baptist Church serving under the leadership of the Keith J. Bigelow Sr. Calvin was a God-fearing, Bible-studying warrior who firmly believed that Jesus Christ was the only answer for the successes he achieved, as well as the challenges he and his family would face and conquer.
