Elder Cardell "CD" Walton was born May 13, 1933 in Mineral Springs, Arkansas, the son of the late Cardell Walton and Willie Lee. He went home to be with the Lord on Thursday, February 25, 2016 at Hurley Medical Center. "CD" attended Howard County Training School in Arkansas and from there moved to Flint, Michigan in 1955. He began working for Chevrolet V-8 Engine Plant, a division of General Motors. "CD" united in marriage to the late Lillie Mae Perry and to this union 2 sons were born, the deceased Christopher Walton and Fester Walton. He also raised 3 nieces, Sharita, Brenda and Linda, and a nephew, Terry. Later in life Elder Walton united in Holy Matrimony to Bertha L. Cannon where she remained at his side until death. Elder Walton was an active member of UAW Local #659 and after 43 years of service he retired from General Motors in 1998. He loved his church and family. Elder Walton was an Associate Elder at Greater New Bethel Church Of God In

Christ where he faithfully served as Superintendent of the Sunday School Department, Chairman of the Trustee Board, and the Songbird at the church where Supt. Brian D. Grundy is the Pastor.
