COLEMAN, Mr. Carl Eugene - Age 79, passed away Wednesday, March 11, 2020 at Medilodge of Grand Blanc, MI. Mr. Coleman will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed Saturday, March 21, 2020 from 10:00 AM - 3:00 PM.

Mr. Carl Eugene Coleman age 79, was born May 13, 1940 in Cairo, Illinois, one of six children born to Willie Mae and Bruce Coleman. Upon the death of his mother, Carl was sent to live with his aunt, Eddie Mae Dossie and was raised as one of her children throughout his childhood.
