HUGHEY, Mr. Carlon - Age 90, passed away Monday, May 23, 2016 at his residence. Family hour 11:00 a.m. Saturday, May 28, 2016 at Kingdom of Heaven Ministries, 2430 Dutcher Rd. with funeral service commencing at 12:00 p.m. Apostle Lonnie Brown officiating. Minister Carlon Hughey, Sr., a World War II Veteran, was born on March 22, 1926, to Odis Lee and Rillia (Morgan) Hughey. Daddy, as many called him, was a very loving and devoted husband, father and grandfather, who never met a stranger. He truly loved the Lord with all his heart and soul and was sure to take time to let others know how much he loved Jesus Christ! One of his many sayings was, "If I had just two people who believed in Jesus Christ, touching and agreeing, we could turn Flint, Michigan and this whole world upside down...do you believe that?" Mr. Hughey worked for Fisher Body I, a division of General Motors for 36 1/2 years before retiring. Daddy was known to everyone in the Dewey School Community as Rev! He was truly a dedicated believer in the faith; he did not lose his life he gave it up for a better one. Our Father was a real example of God's Character.
