Mr. Carolyn Edward Fair was born May 24, 1935 in Bradley, Mississippi, the third born son of Emmitt Jack and Irma Fair. Mr. Fair was known by many as "C.C." He accepted Christ at a young age and was a member of the North Side Baptist Church in Jackson, Mississippi, where he met and married Ms. Lillie Mae Hicks in 1955, to this union six children were born. In 1966, Mr. Fair moved north to Flint, Michigan, seeking for better employment and later moved his family here after being employed for a while with General Motors Corporation. Mr. Fair his wife Lillie Mae Fair and family later became members of the First Trinity Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of Pastor F.O. Hockenhull.
