Ms. Carolyn (Hatter) Brown was born at Hurley Hospital on June 4, 1963, and made her transition on Monday April 21, 2014 at Marina Del Rey Hospital, in Marina Del Rey, California, where family & friends were in attendance. Carolyn Brown attended Flint Schools, graduating from the School of Choice in 1984. Carolyn was a member of the St. George Beth-El Church of God in Christ, under the pastorage of Bishop Arthur George Burrell, where she was reared up in the church's Youth Department: in the Sunshine Band and Purity Class. She loved singing and became a lead singer in the Children's Choir. Carolyn gave her life to the Lord at an early age, not knowing the impact that it would have on her young life. At the age of nine years old, she stood up and testified that "I can sing, let me sing." She loved being in charged and had a passion for Child Care and was trained in Child Care Development by Mother

Norma Burrell and became Assistant Director of the St. George Beth-El Day Care Center. Carolyn, being very talented and adventurous later, moved to Los Angeles, California in 1988. She soon married Mr. Richard Brown and gave birth to beautiful twin girls, Rickeysha and Rickaya. Ms. Brown continued her love and passion for child care and furthered her education and received her Bachelor Degree in Early Childhood Behavior Development in 1999 and obtained her Master Degree from U.C.L.A. in 2000, graduating Suma Kum Laude; with a G.P.A. of 4.0. She worked for the Westside Children Center and Bright Beginning Child Care facilities in Inglewood, CA. Carolyn became a faithful member of the West Angeles Church COGIC, under the leadership of the presiding Bishop Charles E. Blake, sung in the church choir and was a back-up singer for gospel performer Kirk Carr, and musician Stevie Wonder. Carolyn also had a close relationship with renowned singer, Natalie Cole with her care and connection to the Kidney Foundation. Carolyn's favorite past time was watching the sunset, spending time on the beach with family, enjoying her grand baby and spending time with her pet dog, Noodles.
