



## Mr. Carstell "Jack" Peeples

September 13, 1934 - March 11, 2020

PEEPLS, Mr. Carstell "Jack" - Age 85, passed away Wednesday, March 11, 2020 at Kith Haven Skilled Nursing Center. Family hour 10:00 AM Friday, March 20, 2020 at Bethlehem Temple Church of the Apostolic Faith, 3401 Dr. Martin L. King Ave., with funeral service commencing at 11:00 AM. Rev. Phillip Thompson, officiating. Interment Great Lakes National Cemetery, G-4200 Belford Rd., Holly, MI. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10:00 AM Friday. Mr. Peeples will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed 12:00 PM - 8:00 PM Thursday, March 19, 2020.

Mr. Carstell "Jack" Peeples was born September 13, 1934 in Moscow, Tennessee, the son of Neely and Amelia (Wright) Peeples. He attended Spring Hill, TN schools and later enlisted in the United States Army. Carstell served during the Korean War before being Honorably Discharged. He also attended Memphis State University. In 1969, Mr. Peeples married Dorothy Faye Fields and from this union came 5 children, Timothy, Jeanita, Jana, Cassandra and Enos. The family moved from Memphis, TN to Flint, Michigan in 1978. In Flint, the Peeples' family attended the Assembly, Redeemed and Bethlehem Temple churches. He worked for himself as a Carpenter, Brick Layer, Roofer and Construction Worker and taught his son, Tim, many of these skills; the two of them worked side-by-side for several years until Mr. Peeples' health would no longer allow him to work. Prior to his health

declining, Mr. Peeples also volunteered as a Deputy Sheriff at the Hasselbring Senior Center in Flint. His hobbies included, fishing, hunting, playing the guitar and the piano, singing and writing music, writing poetry and playing Connect Four and Solitaire. Mr. Peeples' favorite snacks and drinks included Reese's Peanut Butter Cups, Cheese Puffs, Pepsi and Coffee. He also enjoyed spending time with his family, especially his grandchildren, who affectionately called him "Paw-Paw". He will be missed by many.
