WILLIAMS, Deacon Cecil - Age 79, passed away Saturday, March 21, 2015 at his residence. Family hour 10:30 a.m. Saturday, March 28, 2015 at Mt. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10:30 a.m. Saturday. Deacon Williams will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Deacon Cecil Williams was born on April, 14, 1935 in Atlanta, TX., the son of Mr. and Mrs. Elbert and Elzanie Williams. He was educated in the Texas public school system and graduated from Thornton High School in Queen City, Texas. Deacon Cecil moved to Flint where he gained employment with Truck and Bus, a division of General Motors and C. J. Williams Trucking, until he retired. He was a member of Mt. Hermon Missionary Baptist Church. Deacon Cecil loved gardening, and hunting. If you couldn't find him outside he was somewhere playing cards or dominoes.

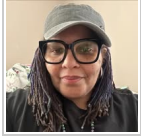
