GREER, Ms. Charlenne T. - Age 73, of Haltom City, Texas, passed away Thursday, May 31, 2012 at North Hills Hospital in North Richland Hills, Texas. Greer was born to Arnold and Gloria Greer, on December 29, 1938, in Detroit, Michigan.
