ANDERSON, Mr. Charles Marion - Age 93, passed away Friday, June 19, 2020 at Hurley Medical Center. Family hour 1:30 PM Tuesday, June 30, 2020 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., with funeral service commencing at 2:00 PM Pastor Steven Bramwell, officiating, Pastor Leon Goerge, Eulogist. Interment Sunset Hills Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the funeral home 1:30 PM Tuesday. Mr. Anderson will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home and may be viewed from 12:00 PM - 6:00 PM Monday with the family present from 4:00 PM - 6:00 PM to receive friends.

Charles Marion "Mickey" Anderson was born April 18, 1927 in Huntsville, Alabama, to the union of the late Susie Ella (Jemison) and Samuel James Anderson Sr. Charles was the 9th of 11 children. He and his family were members of Oakwood College Seventh-Day Adventist Church.

In 1955, with Cookie and "Bae' Bro" (Lloyd) in tow, Charles and Cornelia moved to Flint, Michigan. He and his family united with North Street Seventh-Day Adventist Church where he served as an Ordained Deacon and Elder, Sabbath School Teacher, Sabbath School Superintendent, Minister of Music, Choir Director and Chorister. Charles was a member of North Street/Fairhaven Seventh-Day Adventist Church for 65 years.

Following the footsteps of his father, in 1968 Charles established Anderson's Dry Cleaners located on the corner of Saginaw and Pasadena Avenue. However, that same year, his entrepreneurial spirit motivated him to also establish Anderson's Trucking Co. In 1983, Charles purchased LaSalle Dry Cleaners. Desiring to expand the business he bid and won the dry-cleaning contracts for both the City of Flint and Genesee County Sheriff Department. During this same time, he was employed at Kurtz Gravel Company as a Gravel Train Driver. He retired from Kurtz Gravel Company in October, 1996.

Charles LOVED to sing and his passion was quartet music. He was a former member of the following quartet groups: The Golden Trumpets, The Flint Cavaliers, The Anderson Family Singers and lastly, he formed The New Golden Trumpets which consisted of his children. He was also called on by other groups to assist when needed.

Charles would often state that his greatest joys were singing with his children, piling his children and grandchildren in the motor home for impromptu rides for ice cream, and then on to various Michigan Lakes.

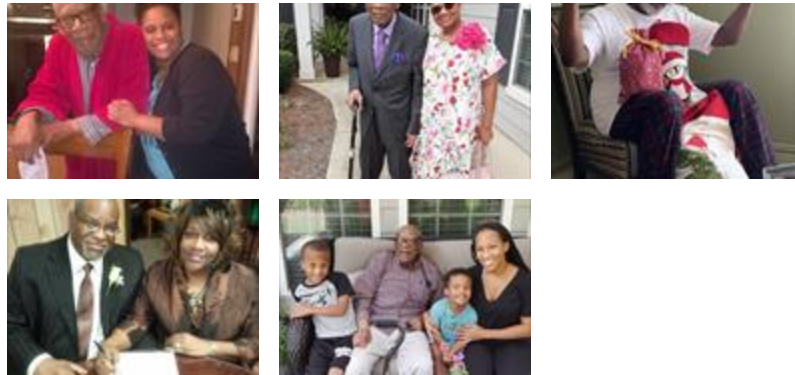
