Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 1-6 p.m. Sunday with family present from 4-6 p.m. Mr. Charles Edgar Stinnett "Chuck" was born on October 18, 1940 in Jonesboro, Arkansas to the union of Elmus and Lillian (Davis) Stinnett. "Chuck" graduated from Booker T. Washington High School in Jonesboro, at the age of 15. He accepted Christ at a young age and was a member of the Genesee Valley Men of Christ, where he served as President of the Usher Board and member of the Male Chorus, Mass Choir and Praise Team. "Chuck" was a member of the New Beginnings Ministries Church and was a former member of Mt. Carmel Baptist Church for twenty-three years. He served his country in the United States Army and was Honorably Discharged. "Chuck" retired from General Motors in 1999, after 37 years of service as a Skilled Trade's Worker. He loved acting and entertaining and was a member of the Buckham Alley Theatre and the McCree Theatre. "Chuck" performed in many plays with his friend and cohort, Dennis Sykes, who introduced him to acting. He also wrote plays and comedy routines, taught workshops, and mentored youth in the Flint Community. "Chuck" was

proud to be called "Thousand" by his only grandchild. Mr. Charles Edgar Stinnett "Chuck" leaves to cherish his memory: son, Gary L. Stinnett; daughter, Courtney T. Stinnett; 1 grandson, Kaylan J.
