Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 11 a.m.-8 p.m. Friday. Mr. Charles F. Woodson was born November 11, 1933 in Fairforest, South Carolina, the son of Gentle Woodson and Blanche Woodson. Charles graduated from Spartanburg County Training School, in South Carolina, "Class of 1952. He was a member of Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church.
