Charlie was the owner of Gray Heating and Cooling Co., and was one of Flint's first African American business owners licensed in Heating and Cooling. He was a retired General Motors Corporation, worker of 40 years. He also served in the Korean War. Mr. Williams leaves to cherish his memory: devoted wife, Catherine M. Williams; 4 daughters, Pamela, Claudia, Natalie and Nicole, all of Chicago, IL; 4 sons, Chas, Ronald, Lance and James, all of Flint; 3 sisters, Helen McBride of Flint, Frances DeCarlos of Toledo, OH and Cletis Williams of Woodland, MS; 1 brother, Joe Williams of Flint; a host of relatives and friends.
