PONDER, Charlotte - age 64, passed away Wednesday, July 23, 2014 at her residence. Family hour 10:30 a.m. Wednesday, July 30, 2014 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Charlotte Ponder was born on May 5, 1950 in Flint, Michigan the daughter of the late Henry Edward & Dorothy Lee (Lockhart) Ponder. Charlotte was a resident of Flint; but resided in Arkansas, California, and New Jersey over the years. Charlotte accepted the Lord Our Savior Jesus Christ at a young age. She was baptized at Mt. Olive Missionary Baptist Church, located in Flint, Michigan. Charlotte never wavered from her Baptist upbringing, she frequented First Trinity Missionary Baptist Church and Grace Emanuel Missionary Baptist Church over the years. Charlotte attended Clark Community School, Bryant Jr. High and in 1968 graduated from Flint Northwestern High School. Just as many young adults were able to do in the 1970's, she began working at the former AC Spark Plug and was an active retiree upon her death. Charlotte loved to draw and sketch keeping numerous journals filled with her favorite pastime. In addition, she loved to shop

especially for shoes and purses. She always wore jewelry to coordinate with her outfits. She loved to “dress to impress.” Charlotte was a loving and caring Aunt to her Nieces and Nephews often taking them on trips to cultural events, or the movies.
