Christopher Lensey Echols was born on March 4, 1974 to Lensey Earl Mason and Vickie Sue

Echols in Flint, MI. At an early age Christopher used to watch his uncle Kenneth take apart

radios and TVs. He started to work on circuits and anything electrical while in elementary

school. When Chris was in high school he excelled in all his classes and graduated with honors

in 1992 from Flint Northern High School. Christopher graduated from General Motors Institute

(GMI) undergraduate electrical engineering program in 1997. While working full time and raising

his son as a single parent, Chris pursued and accomplished obtaining a master's in science in Lean Manufacturing with a concentration in GM Global Leadership with a 4.0 GPA from Kettering University. Christopher was employed at General Motors for over 30 years.

Chris was much like John Henry, an old folklore about an African American man who worked on the railroads and believed that he could work harder and longer than a steam drill using two hammers. John was right! The steam drill stopped working and John had won the challenge of man against machine. Two days later John died from what folks believed to be from the stress of the competition. Just like John, Chris worked day in and day out and was a 'steel-driven man' The "machine" for Chris was his exemplary work ethic and his dream for his son to graduate from college.

Christopher loved the Star Wars franchise, comic books, live boxing matches, collectible action figures, painting and he had an obsession with watches. He was a vintner and wine connoisseur.

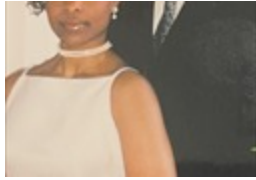

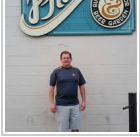
