Mrs. Clara Mae Clark-Lomax was born in Montgomery County, Mississippi, the second of three children born to the union of, Dave and Annie (Pittman) Olton. Sister Lomax received her education in the Montgomery County School System, graduating from Spring Hill Vocational High School and Coahoma Junior College; receiving a Teacher's Certificate, which enabled her to teach in Mississippi and Alabama.

Sister Lomax was employed at McLaren Hospital, and she served in various capacities. After a while, she gained employment at Flint Osteopathic Hospital. It was at Flint Osteopathic that a mentor noticed her gift in nursing and encouraged her to go back to school. Sister Lomax took heed to that guidance and enrolled at Mott Community College, graduating with honors receiving an Associate Degree as a Registered Nurse. After working another year at Flint Osteopathic Hospital, Sister Lomax gained employment at Hurley Medical Center. There she was trained to work specifically in the area of

dialysis, however, it was in the psychiatric ward where she found her niche, and she retired as a psychiatric nurse in 1996, after 28 years of service. After moving to Flint, Michigan in 1958, Sister Lomax united in worship with the New Zion Missionary Baptist Church, under the leadership of Rev. Dr. W.G. Terry, and has been a loyal and faithful member ever since.
