Claude Stewart’s family was just one of the many five million African Americans from the Second Great migration who moved from the south to North, Midwest or West in search of better housing, education, employment and land. After one family member would establish himself, he reached back to assist siblings and other family members to help them make their move. James, one of Claude’s older brothers was the first one to move from Crawfordville, Georgia to Cincinnati, Ohio. And somewhere in between the other Stewart siblings left the South.

Claude’s parents were Sallie and Willie Stewart, Jr. in addition his brothers were Willie (1986), Fred Sr. (1983), James (1993), Alfonzo (1993), Johnny (1940) and his sisters were Annie (1967) and Rebecca (year of departure

unknown) all whom have departed.

Claude and his wife had no biological children, but served as surrogate parents to many.

Left to carry on his beautiful legacy are his sister, Vellenia Stewart; nieces, Alma Robinson, Pamela Stewart, Shirley Williams (Cincinnati, OH), Marcella Llewellyn (Chicago, Illinois); nephews, Fred Stewart, Jr., Robert (Brenda) Stewart, William Stewart, Cleve Franklin, Ralph (Eleanor) Stewart, Anthony Stewart (Cincinnati, Ohio), Michael Stewart (Atlanta, Georgia); longtime caregiver, Anne Miles (Water Valley, Mississippi) and friend, Eleanor Giles Flint, Michigan.

In addition, Claude Stewart is survived by other family members, friends and most importantly a strong loving, faithful and supportive church family.
