GALLON, Mr. Clifton, Jr. - Age 71, passed away Wednesday, December 3, 2008 in Madison, Tennessee. Family hour 10:30AM Friday, December 12, 2008 at Grace Emmanuel Baptist Church, 3502 Lapeer Rd., with funeral service commencing at 11AM, Pastor Marvin A. Jennings, Sr., officiating. Interment Sunset Hills Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10:30AM Friday. Mr. Clifton will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12Noon-8PM Thursday with preferred visitation from 5PM-7PM. Mr. Clifton Gallon Jr. was born on October 30, 1937 in Star City, Arkansas to Clifton and Clara (Mockingbird) Gallon. He spent his youth in Arkansas where he accepted Christ and was baptized at Sneed Chapel Baptist Church in Phoenix, Arkansas. After graduating from Lincoln High School, Clifton moved to Muskegon Heights, Michigan with mother Clara and stepfather James Grimm. He moved to Flint, Michigan and became employed with General Motors V-8 engine plant in 1961 where he retired after 33 years of service. Clifton served the Lord as Chief Usher, Trustee, Sunday School van driver, GCSO Security In Ministry, sound ministry, baptismal set up, church contact for alarms, ensuring vans and church were secured, and a host of other duties while a member at Mt. Calvary Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of the late Dr. Granville Smith Jr. and then Pastor Henry L. Fuller Jr. He later joined the Antioch Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of Rev. Louis Randolph where he served with the

usher ministry. Clifton continued his service until his health declined then began to attend church with his daughter Cheryl at Grace Emmanuel Baptist Church. He was a member of UAW Local 659 and the Eureka Lodge No. 16 F. & A.M. Clifton enjoyed reading his Bible, music, maintaining his yard, gardening, watching westerns and comedies, and was an avid car lover. His favorite color was red and he loved shrimp, strawberries, ice cream, and anything sweet.
