MARTIN, Mr. Clyde L. - Age 83, passed away Tuesday, August 23, 2016 at Hurley Medical Center. Family hour 10:00 A.M. Wednesday, August 31, 2016 at International Gospel Center, 4126 Fenton Rd., with funeral service commencing at 11:00 A.M. Pastor Gillie Harris, Jr. officiating. Interment Great Lakes National Cemetery, G-4200 Belford Rd., Holly, MI. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at church 10:00 A.M. Mr. Martin will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed 12:00 P.M. - 8:00 P.M. Tuesday.

Mr. Clyde L. Martin was born August 2, 1933 in Portersville, Missouri, the son of the late Lacy and Laura Martin. Clyde was resilient as a young man and grew up to be very firm and strong willed. He went off to serve in the United States Army until his retirement in 1961. Because family was important, he moved to Chicago to be with his brothers. Clyde, a "skilled" craftsman, worked several odd jobs before finding his nitch at R& D Decorating where he worked for 14 years as a painter and dry wall scraper. He then worked the following 15 years for Smykl Incorporated, where he was in charge of maintenance. Clyde was a hard-worker. After his retirement he moved to Flint and married the love of his life, Leatha, on August 8, 1998. He rededicated his life to the Lord and became an active member of the International Gospel Center in Flint, under the leadership of Pastor Gillie Harris, Jr., where he was appointed to the Deacon Board. Clyde loved spending time with his friends at McDonalds, talking on the phone to his siblings and "tearing stuff up."

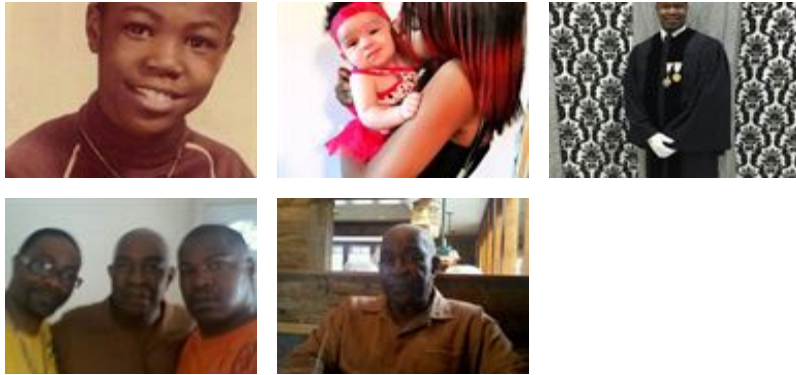
